**DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION: MAY 1, 2020**

### Ideal Mini Award General Criteria for Selection:

- Students may only apply for these awards in their graduating year
- Minimum 90% average in required courses for scholarship and no marks under 60% in any course
- Required courses must be taken at Ideal
- Must take a minimum of 5 total courses at Ideal. Preference may be given to those who have a greater course load but can still maintain a strong overall average.
- Preferably has plans for post-secondary education

*Please note that these awards may not necessarily be given to students with the top academic scores. These awards may not be given out each year if there are no applicants or suitable candidates, as determined by the selection committee.*

**Step 1** – Please indicate the award(s) you are applying for:

- Science/Math - \$200
- Art/Drama (Fine Arts) - \$200
- English/History (Humanities) - \$200
- French - \$100

- a. Must meet all Ideal Mini Award General Criteria for Selection list above
- b. Required courses at Ideal Mini:
  - i. PreCalculus 12
  - ii. 3 of Chemistry 11/Biology 11/Physics 11/Biology 12
- c. At least 2 must be Science 12 courses
- d. At least one other Science 12 taken outside of Ideal Mini
- e. Demonstrates a passion for science in and outside of the classroom (e.g. Senior Science Fair Projects, science workshops or camps, science initiatives)
- f. Preferably planning to pursue science in post-secondary school
